



## ***TFFC RULES – 18 July 2011***

1. Only conventional fly fishing tackle may be used and specifically barbless hook flies.
2. Members should be in possession of a current Trout Licence - failure to do so could expose the Member to prosecution by the Provincial Nature Conservation Authorities.
3. TFFC supports FOSAF and encourages all members to join the Association. All new members applying to TFFC will be required to join FOSAF.
4. The Accommodation Register must be completed on arrival by all persons visiting the farm.
5. The Fishing Record must be completed each day, by each person fishing, recording details of each fish killed and the number of fish returned.
6. The maximum daily bag limit is 4 fish per rod, or 6 per party, with a maximum of 2 fish per rod per dam. Fishing must cease on a dam once the bag limit of 2 is reached and for the day when the daily bag limit is reached.  
  
Special temporary limits may be applied to one or more of the dams from time to time and will be communicated via the Notice Board and/or by the News-letter.
7. All fish must be cleaned at the dam and the entrails returned to the water.
8. No dogs or shooting (without DTF Directors' permission) permitted on the property.
9. No wild flowers may be picked.
10. No driving to the dams with the exception of Dam 1 and Dam 3 where vehicles may be parked in the demarcated areas only. The only other exceptions are work parties or with special permission.

11. Under no circumstances are fires to be started anywhere on the farm, with the exception of the braai facilities provided at the house.
12. Under no circumstances will smoking be allowed anywhere in the house.
13. Under no circumstances will the wearing of gumboots/waders be tolerated in the house.
14. Litter will not be tolerated. All bottles, cans, plastic or non bio-degradable refuse (including cigarette ends) must be removed from the farm on departure.
15. Under no circumstances may television sets, radios or electric heaters be used.
16. Boat fishing is permitted at own risk on Dam 3 only. Float tubes or kick boats may be used on any dam but bank anglers have right of way.
17. Accommodation must be reserved through the Booking Officer (office hours only, Monday to Friday):

Please note that bookings may only be made up to 3 months in advance.

If there is no accommodation available on the weekend of your choice, you may request the booking officer to place you on the waiting list and to notify you of any cancellations that may arise.

Day Visitors must also notify the Booking Officer of intended visits.

18. Members are allowed one guest or guest party per month.

19. Weekends are defined as Friday to Sunday or part thereof.

A fee of R500 will be charged which includes 1 or 2 nights, a maximum of 2 guest rods, a guest room if required and a maximum of 4 people per guest party. An additional fee of R250 is payable for each additional night.

20. Week days are defined as Sunday to Thursday.

A fee of R250 will be charged per night, a maximum of 2 guest rods, a guest room if required and a maximum of 4 people per guest party. An additional fee of R250 is payable for each additional night.

21. A fee of R125.00 will be charged per guest rod should guests only visit the farm for a day.

22. No guests allowed on long weekends unless sharing the members room or unless there is accommodation spare.

Spare accommodation is defined as a spare room/s on the Monday of the week in which a long weekend falls. If a public holiday falls on a Thursday, Friday, Monday or a Tuesday, this will be deemed a long weekend.

23. Guest fees must be paid directly into the following bank account:

The deposit confirmation must be sent to the Booking Officer via fax or e-mail before the visit takes place.

24. The domestic servants must be paid R4.00 per person per day (or part thereof). This money is to be handed to the Weekend Warden upon arrival, who will enter into the receipt book and give to the servants by noon on Saturday.

25. All members' children over the age of 21 are to become members in their own right or pay guest fees as stated above. The only exception to this rule is in respect of full time university or college students. In order to qualify for this concession the member must notify the club secretary in writing by the end of January annually, otherwise guest fees will apply.

26. Please enter any problems, suggestions or maintenance issues into the Maintenance Book situated in the shareholders block.

27. Members are required to present their membership cards at any time upon request when visiting the farm.
